Provincial's Message

Dear Bishops, Fathers and Brothers Greetings from St. Xavier's Provincial House Rajkot!

As we approach the midpoint of this academic year and prepare for a break, along with the spiritual enlightenment that our upcoming retreats promise, it is an opportune time for self-reflection on our individual and collective strengths. Notably, our province has embarked on another chapter in our global mission with a mission in Namibia, where three of our fathers are serving.

This year, our congregation has chosen "communitarian witnessing" as the theme, which holds deep significance in the light of the challenges and opportunities that lie ahead. Remember the words from 1 John 3:18, "Let us not just love with words or speech but with actions and truth." Let's commit to nurturing a culture of constructive and compassionate communication within our community, supporting each other in our faith journey. I strongly encourage each of you to engage in thoughtful and sincere introspection, contemplating how the following aspects may impact our communitarian witnessing:

It is our religious identity that forms the foundation for all the mission tasks we undertake. Identify the issues that can lead to crises in any area of life. One major cause of identity loss in today's priestly and religious life is the emergence of hyphenated roles in the religious community. This mistaken identity can cause considerable trouble within the community and affect our religious call. But what does it mean to be a hyphenated religious? Robert F. Drinan SJ, in his book "Can God and Caesar Coexist?" defines a

"hyphenated priest" as a priest whose vocation involves various ministries beyond sacramental duties, a priest who takes on other responsibilities.

Do we struggle with identity issues because of these hyphenated roles? In religious life, it often seems that emphasizing one's religious identity is crucial. All other identities should be secondary to our religious identity. It is possible to have multiple hyphenated identities if they complement one's religious identity and spiritual life.

It's crucial that we ask ourselves the following question: Have I compromised my religious identity for the sake of any of these hyphenated roles?

To sum it up, it's important to maintain a strong religious identity while blending it with other roles. It's essential for us to continuously assess and ensure that these additional identities enhance rather than undermine our religious and spiritual life.

In the spirit of unity, let's pledge to support one another, inspire our fellow members, embrace the diversity that each of us bring, and recognize the unique gifts we offer. Through this unity, we can create a splendid tapestry of collective achievements and blessings. Remember the wisdom of Proverbs 27:17, "Iron sharpens iron, and one person sharpens another." Consider how, as collective, we can steadfastly uphold and strengthen our cherished values, even in the face of adversity.

He has embarked on his new mission trusting our continued prayers and support. All the best and God's blessings to Fr. Jerry.


Birth of New Book

Career Counselling Seminars- Mission Margadarshan

Commemorating the victory of good over evil and spreading the message of unity, Navratri Celebration was held in the school for the students and staff on 16 October, 2023.


Rosary Celebration
